OLS SUPPLY LIST FOR THE 25-26 SCHOOL YEAR

All students should bring a reusable water bottle to fill at school. Please see your grade level list to see if your child's teacher has specific requirements for the water bottle.

MRS. KAREN (3K): 1- box of 24 Crayons, 3- Jumbo purple glue sticks, 1- Glue bottle, 1- Crayola watercolor set with brush, 1- Roll-up sleeping mat for full time students, 1- Small dry-erase whiteboard, 1- package of different colors dry erase markers, 1- Pencil box, 2- 2 pocket folders, Extra set of clothes (shirt, pants, shorts, underwear, socks) in a Ziploc bag with child's name on it, 1- Full Size Backpack (not toddler size please). Any paper towel, Kleenex, baby wipes, Clorox disinfectant wipes, gallon and/or sandwich size Ziploc bags, small and/or large paper plates, paper bowls, and individual wrapped healthy snacks are greatly appreciated.

MISS MEGAN (4K): 1 or 2 Bottles of white glue, Backpack, Crayons, Markers, Pencils (fat pencils), Paint smock (old t-shirts work great), Watercolor paint set, Rest mat (sleeping bag, blanket and pillow, anything comfy works) Kleenex, Baby wipes, Disinfectant wipes, Paper towels, Paper Plates, Water bottle, A gallon sized bag with a full set of clothes that is labeled with the child's name that will stay in the classroom, Always appreciated are snacks for the children to share throughout the year.

MRS. PILAR (KINDER.): Backpack, markers (washable, no skinny markers, regular colors are best), paint smock, scissors (blunt end Fiskars for Kids are great), bottle of white glue (gel glue does not work as well), large glue stick, large eraser, crayons, primary pencils (fat). Snacks, Paper towels, disinfectant wipes, and Kleenex donations are greatly appreciated.

MRS. TINDOL (1ST GRADE): Backpack, White glue, white glue sticks, markers, pencils, scissors, big eraser, pencil cap erasers, 3 folders, Kleenex, wide lined spiral notebook, Crayola watercolor paints. Donations of Paper towels, wipes and Kleenex are appreciated.

MRS. LUEBKE (2ND GRADE): Washable markers, colored pencils, crayons, pencil box to hold them all; 2 large glue sticks, scissors, #2 pencils, pencil top erasers, 1 large pink eraser, 2 - 2 pocket folders, 2 wide ruled notebooks, watercolor paints, backpack, headphones for computers, donation of Kleenex and pre-packaged snack items for the class are appreciated.

MRS. ZIMMER (3RD & 4TH GRADE): Washable markers, colored pencils, crayons, pencil box to hold them all; 2 large glue sticks, scissors, #2 pencils, pencil top erasers, 1 large pink eraser, 1 red pen, 1 yellow highlighter, 2 - 2 pocket folders, 2 wide ruled notebooks, watercolor paints, handheld pencil sharpener, water bottle that is not a Stanley or of the like, with a spout that closes, backpack, headphones for computers, donation of Kleenex and pre-packaged snack items for the class.

MRS. SCHALINSKE (P.E.): All students should have appropriate footwear on P.E. days. No Crocs or Hey Dudes, please! Middle School students are asked to change into appropriate clothing and bring deodorant, also.

MRS. COGGINS (ELEMENTARY ART): Pencil box, coloring utensils, scissors and a glue stick.

MS. BRUCE (TECHNOLOGY): Inexpensive earbuds or headphones.

STUDENTS IN GRADES 5-6-7-8 SWITCH TEACHERS FOR CLASSES SO THEY NEED TO HAVE ALL THE FOLLOWING SUPPLIES.

MRS. WEBER (ELA/RELIGION): Paper (whatever keeps them the best organized-whether this is notebooks or a binder), pencils, pens (1 red to check with), either markers, crayons, or colored pencils, scissors, Kleenex, big pack of post-it notes, 3 highlighters, notebook for journaling, disinfecting wipes (any brand).

MR. BANDLI (MATH/SCIENCE): calculator (required – just a simple inexpensive one but should have the square root function), ruler, notebook or lined paper for assignments, pencil supply throughout the year, red pen for correcting, 1 folder, a composition book. Donations of Kleenex, paper towel and disinfectant wipes are appreciated.

MS. BRUCE (SOCIAL STUDIES): notebook, black or blue pens, pencils

MRS. COGGINS (MS ART): Colored pencils, markers (broad and fine tipped), a button down shirt or apron that can be worn over clothes, a sketch book the size of a normal notebook. There may be more supplies asked for as the year progresses.

Assignment notebooks will be provided for students in 3rd grade and up.

STUDENTS ARE REQUIRED TO COVER THEIR TEXTBOOKS. Please do not use the book covers similar to contact paper. These leave a sticky residue on the books. Paper bags work and will protect the books the best!
